Eduardo Bosio is Latin America's first young lyrical-pop voice. At the age of 25, he made his debut at the Teatro Colón, one of the most renowned theaters in the world, as a member of the Teatro Colón's permanent choir.

He was trained in Argentina, the United States, and Germany. His voice, with its strong lyrical foundation, allows him to excel across various genres, and he is initially a respected classical singer at the Argentine Teatro Colón.

Eduardo has merged with producer Robert Brandon Valencia of Solid Sound Entertainment based in Los Angeles, California.

This partnership has produced moving performances by blending the lyrical versatility of Eduardo Bosio's voice, creating Argentina's first lyrical pop album. In the album, Bosio is masterfully accompanied by the prestigious Sofia Symphony Orchestra (Bulgaria).
